NEEDS ASSESSMENT. Ms Lesser said that after FCAT she would get input from all the teachers regarding Needs Assessment. The FCAT camp will need some restructuring and areas of weakness will be addressed.

Mr. Jenkins discussed the construction at the school. The roof repairs are ongoing. They will work after hours in March and won't be at the school tomorrow or Wednesday due to FCAT Writes.

After the roof repairs are done and once FCAT's are over another company has been hired to change all the lights and toilets. They will be updated according to energy saving standards.

Tomorrow is the 4th Grade FCAT Writes. The children have worked hard and are ready. The 6-ers club met in small groups and the kids seemed to enjoy it and learned quite a bit.
